

Applications are invited from eligible candidates for one post each of Urban Transport Planner and Urban Transport Engineer in Institute of Urban Transport (India) [IUT], Delhi as per details given below latest by 15.12.2020:

1. About the Institute

The Institute of Urban Transport (India) (IUT) was established in May, 1997 under the purview of the erstwhile Ministry of Urban Development now Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs (MoHUA), Government of India as a premier professional non-profit making organization and registered under the Societies Registration Act. The membership of the Institute comprises Academicians, Architects, Economists, Engineers, Transport Planners, Town Planners and professionals from various other disciplines. The Institute has 67 institutional members and about 1600 individual members. It has association with foreign organizations such as LTA Singapore, GIZ and KfW from Germany, CODATU, France and KOTI, South Korea. The Secretary, MoHUA, Government of India, is the ex-officio President of the Institute. The Officer on Special Duty (UT) and Ex-officio Joint Secretary in the Ministry is the Acting Director General of the Institute. It has three tiers of management, namely Executive Committee, Governing Council and General Body.

2 Aims and Objectives

The aims and objectives of the Institute are to promote, encourage and coordinate the state of the art of urban transport, including planning, development, operation, education, research and management and also to organize lectures, seminars, workshops, conferences, etc. on the subjects pertaining to urban transport. In addition, the Institute provides professional support to MoHUA for its various projects and initiatives, such as appraisal of Metro Rail / Urban Transport projects received for central assistance, organizing an annual Urban Mobility Conference cum Exhibition, several workshops and capacity building programmes.

One of the ongoing activities is to provide handholding to the various State Governments / Urban Local Bodies / Corporations on request or with whom IUT has signed MoUs to be their knowledge partner.

3. Recruitment

Recruitment for one post each of Urban Transport Planner and Urban Transport Engineer

- i. **Qualifications and Experience**– The applicant should have a bachelor’s degree in Engineering/ Architecture/ Planning and master’s degree in Transport Planning/ Transport Engineering or an equivalent degree awarded by a recognized university or institution, such as M.Tech Infrastructure Engg. Design; Masters of Technology; M.Tech (Centre for Transportation Systems); Master of Technology; M.Tech in Transportation Engineering; M.Tech in Infrastructure Systems; M. Plan (Urban Transport Planning & Management); Master of Technology: Transportation Engineering; etc. with minimum 3 years’ experience after attaining master’s degree. Candidates with higher qualifications and experience would also be eligible to apply.
- ii. **Maximum Age Limit** - An upper age limit of 40 years is prescribed as on date of issue of this advertisement.

- iii. **Remuneration** – Selected candidates shall be given a suitable consolidated remuneration commensurate with their experience.
 - iv. **Selection Process** – The shortlisted candidates will be screened and interviewed virtually by the Recruitment and Remuneration Committee of IUT through online portal (Webex).
