
Sir,

Subject: - Awards for Excellence in Urban Transport

As in the previous years, the 3rd Annual Conference and Exhibition on 'Urban Mobility' 2010, sponsored by Ministry of Urban Development, Govt. of India, will be held from 3rd to 5th December 2010 in Delhi. At this conference, like in the previous years, awards will be given to 'Best Practice' projects in urban transport. Based on the past experience, a few changes has been made in the award categories as explained in attached annexure-A which may please be noted. Kindly note that two categories of awards are being dropped and the scope of three categories of awards has been modified. Accordingly for the year 2010, awards for 'Best Practice' projects in Urban Transport will be conferred in the following eight categories :-

- i. Best PPP initiative in Urban Transport
- ii. Best NMT project (Pedestrian/ Cycle Rickshaw/ Cycle Transport Project)
- iii. Best Urban Mass Transit Project (BRT, Metro, LRT etc.)
- iv. Best Clean Development Mechanism Project
- v. Best Intelligent Transport System Project
- vi. Best Integrated Multimodal Transportation System
- vii. New Technological Applications / innovations
- viii. Overall excellence for Urban Transport for the city – 'Urban Transport Trophy'

2. The following points may also be noted :


- i. No award will be given to private consultants.
- ii. In future, the proposal for award will be considered only for those projects/ plans proposed by the city/parastatal which have been either implemented fully or substantially. In order to give time to the cities for implementation of Comprehensive Mobility Plan (CMP), award for CMP would be started a few years hence.
- iii. The award for **Overall Excellence for Urban Transport for City** would be made on the basis of progress of implementation of various facets of National Urban

Transport Policy (NUTP) mainly the following :-

- a) Whether implementation of CMP is in progress
 - b) Whether citywide public transport system has been planned & is being introduced as per an approved program
 - c) Whether intermodal and seamless connectivity is a part of item (b) above.
 - d) Whether facilities for NMT are being provided as a part of item (b) above.
 - e) Whether Benchmarking of Service Level Benchmarks on UT has been done and what is improvement thereof.
- iv. Projects which were selected for awards in the earlier years would not be eligible for subsequent years.
- v. A committee or a group of members of the 'Awards committee' would undertake a visit to the city/ cities being considered under the special category '**Overall Excellence for Urban Transport for City**' to help get a first- hand knowledge of the achievements claimed by the city in support of their entry for the awards in this category.
3. The Awardees will be selected by a committee of experts constituted by the Ministry of Urban Development, Govt. of India. You are requested to send entries for Awards for 'best practice' projects and overall Excellence separately by 31st August, 2010 with a two page summary of the project as per attached Performa.
